Hurricane Irene left her mark on the Villages of Westminster, but it was small compared to other areas; for that we're thankful! Clean-up started just a couple weeks after the storm blew through our community. The Villages of Westminster is responsible for tree removal and clean-up of the common areas scattered throughout the neighborhood. After doing a walkthrough of the neighborhood and evaluating recommendations that came in from homeowners, we sought estimates from four local tree companies. 21 trees needed care, ranging from complete removal to pruning damaged branches. A few posed safety hazards and needed to be addressed immediately, the remaining were addresses over the next few weeks.
