RECYCLING CHANGES COMING SOON

Beginning this July, the Virginia Peninsula Public Service Authority will be changing its recycling program, which will now be managed by County Waste. All residents will receive a 65-gallon rolling recycling bin which will be picked up bi-weekly. Because of the change in the trucks used for collection, the new containers will need be placed at your curb with the lid facing toward the street.
