

How do I access the pool?

During pool season (typically Memorial Day through Labor Day), the community pool is accessible to all residents who are in good standing. Pool hours will be posted on the VOW website and at the pool entrance.

Access to the pool is granted with your VOW electronic key card.

How do I access the clubhouse?

The community clubhouse is available for rent by all residents in good standing.

With a reservation, access to the community clubhouse is granted with your VOW electronic key card.

Why do we need key cards?

- 1.) Key cards will limit unauthorized access to the community pool and clubhouse.
- 2.) A computer record is kept of when a key card is used to enter the clubhouse or pool.
- 3.) Lost cards will be disabled/deactivated from the system immediately when a replacement card is issued.

Do I need to use my key card to access the pool/clubhouse restrooms? No, the community restrooms will be unlocked and available during pool hours and authorized club house functions.

Will I still receive an annual pool pass in the mail? No, the monitored key card has replaced the pool pass.

Do I need to keep the card with me at the pool or the clubhouse? Yes. You will need to keep the card with you during events at the clubhouse or while at the pool during swim season. Both the clubhouse door and pool gate lock very quickly after unlocking with the key card.

Is the key card affected by magnets? No.

Will the card work in a pocket or wallet? Yes.

Is the card water proof? Yes.

Do I need to swipe the card? No – holding the card near the reader is sufficient.
